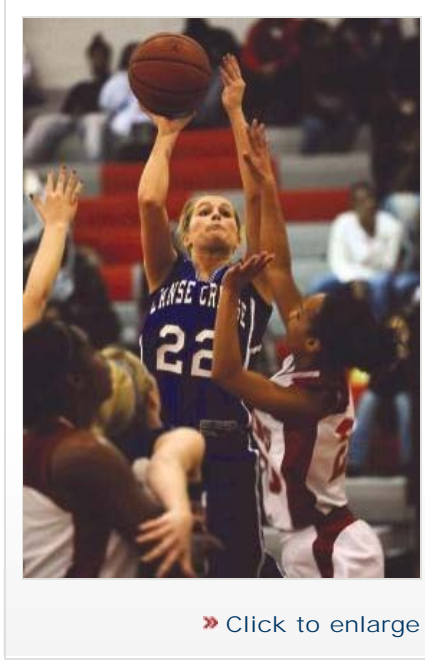

There's nothing unique about bathers stepping lightly into the water to check the temperature.

Trouble is, these Bathers were members of coach Wilbur Jones' Mount Clemens girls basketball team. The way they started the game against L'Anse Creuse on Wednesday night, it certainly did not look like they were going to clean up in this Macomb Area Conference Blue Division contest.

Mount Clemens managed just seven points in the first quarter, and five in the second as they fell behind 16-12 at halftime.

However, Mount Clemens came up with a 32-point second half and the Bathers came back to grab a hard-fought 44-42 victory to raise their record to 3-2, 8-7. L'Anse Creuse fell to 2-4 in the league.

"We were shaky in the first half," said Jones. "We had a few turnovers. We were nervous because the players put a lot of pressure on themselves. We picked it up in the second half. We pushed the ball up the court."

Janice Cunningham and Shantelle Jones scored 12 apiece for the Bathers. Cunningham also had five steals. Mariah Spicer scored nine, grabbed 12 rebounds and had six blocks. Dashanna Turner scored nine, grabbed seven rebounds and had six assists.

L'Anse Creuse was led by Carlay Stahl, who scored 14.
